CLEAN BRUSHES - Can't tell you how much this affects your skin overall and makeup application and will be super helpful to work with clean tools

HOW TO CLEAN BRUSHES STEP BY STEP

- 1. Ensure you don't get anything below the brush hairs or wet the handle
- 2. Use Dawn dish soap and warm to hot water (it works!) I prefer hotter helps with getting the color out better
- 3. Wet brush and add soap, let it lather
- 4. Rinse

- 5. Repeat for more stubborn brushes or colors lingering
- 6. Lay flat to dry overnight
- 7. Fluff and ready for use
- 8. Do every 1-2 weeks depending on usage


WHAT YOU'LL NEED FOR THE LESSON

- Concealer 1 year
- Powders (foundation or eyeshadows) 2 years
- Bronzer, Blushes 2 years
